Experience in teaching/advising/mentoring low income, first generation, educationally disadvantaged and at-risk students. Work rules, code of conduct and other policies comprise essential functions of the job. Ability to communicate effectively with students and college personnel. Teach day and/or evening classes. Travel to teach at other SWTJC sites may be required.
