Construction

Eagle Pass Academic –General contractor has reported that he is 9 days ahead of schedule. The first third of the concrete was poured on March 10, 2015.

Eagle Pass Technical Campus – Our architect has been working with lowest bid contractor to value engineer the project (find ways to reduce cost). We hope to have a revised bid to the board at our March Board meeting.

Crystal City – We have a couple of site layout considerations for the Board. Placement of the campus sign, a marque, adding additional parking in the vacant lot. We should have bids for board consideration at our April Board meeting.

Legislation

The House subcommittee on Appropriations has finished up their markup of the funding bill, added about \$40 million to the community college base (about half of what we were cut). I have contacted our representatives and urged them to visit with their colleagues to improve our funding.
