



## CLINICAL MEDICAL ASSISTANT WITH PHLEBOTOMY

As a Clinical Medical Assistant and Phlebotomist, the student will be trained to help the physician carry out procedures, care for patients, perform basic lab tests and administer medications. The Clinical Medical Assistant and Phlebotomist work in a physician's office or a clinic or hospital setting. This course combines classroom instruction of 150 hours and externship of 160 hours to provide students with a comprehensive learning experience. This course includes 7 hours of First Aid/CPR for the healthcare provider.
