



CLINICAL MEDICAL ASSISTANT

As a Clinical Medical Assistant, the student will be trained to help the physician carry out procedures, care for patients, perform basic lab tests and administer medications. The Clinical Medical Assistant works in a physician's office or a clinic setting. This course combines classroom instruction of hours and externship hours to provide students with a comprehensive learning experience. This course includes 8 hours of First Aid/CPR for the healthcare provider.
